



ORAL SALINE for Veterinary Use

Description

Vet Saline is a specially designed oral saline for veterinary use. It is composed of anhydrous glucose, sodium chloride, potassium chloride and sodium citrate (as dihydrate).

Sodium Citrate (as dihydrate)	BP	5.80	gm
Anhydrous Glucose	BP	27.00	gm

Usage

- ▶ Replacement of fluid and electrolyte loss due to
 - Acute diarrhea
 - Dehydration
- ▶ Stress

Preparation of **Vet Saline**

- Mix full contents of the sachet in 2 liters of pure drinking water.
- Do not mix the **Vet Saline** with hot water or heat the prepared solution
- Discard the unused prepared **Vet Saline** after 12 hours of preparation

Dosage and administration

The equal amount of water that is excreted from the body should be administered to rehydrate the animal.

Packing

10 packets/box.
